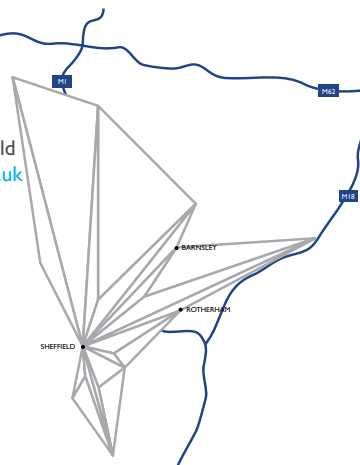

WHAT ARE THE ENTRY QUALIFICATIONS AND EXPERIENCE I NEED?

You need a relevant degree, Maths and English GCSE (& Science for primary) grade C and to pass a skills test. Recent relevant work experience is desirable but not essential. If you are intending to apply to The Sheffield SCITT and would like experience prior to this, please contact us via the details at the bottom of the page.

WHAT ARE THE FEES AND FINANCE?

Fees are: PGCE and QTS £9250, QTS only £7850. Fees are payable either by student loan or privately funded. Bursaries and scholarships of up to £30,000 are available in some subjects depending on your degree class.

2. Interviews involve teaching a short activity, a reflective task and answering formal questions from subject specialists.
